### **Summer Holiday Hours**

During the school term, the Splash Park in Queanbeyan Pool will open from 3pm to 5pm on weekdays and continue to operate from 10am to 5pm on weekends.

During the school term, Captains Flat will also reduce hours from 2:30pm to 6:30pm on weekdays and continue to operate from 11am to 6:30pm on weekends.

### **Venue Capacity Limits**

As you would be aware, when it is hot, we get a lot more visitors to our venues as we know everyone's keen to cool off. Please remember that our pools have a maximum capacity for everyone's comfort and safety, which is determined by the size of the facility and the number of lifeguards on duty.

When the pool reaches its maximum patronage, the gates will temporarily close. New patrons will only be admitted as existing patrons leave.

### **Term One Swimming Lessons**

In Queanbeyan, lessons will run from Monday 2 February to Thursday 2 April 2026. In Braidwood, lessons will run from Tuesday 3 February to Thursday 12 March 2026.

Whilst lessons are on, lane availability reduces.

### **Direct Debit Memberships**

QPRC Aquatics recognises that there may be circumstances where members are unable to utilise their membership due to medical reasons. In such cases, the venue allows for temporary suspension of the membership.

Memberships cannot be put on hold for any other reason. You are better off financially purchasing a Direct Debit Membership if you intend to visit our venues at least once a week. This usage over the whole year needs to be taken into consideration. Therefore, you cannot request a temporary suspension to go on holiday for two weeks, especially if you regularly visit the venue three times a week.

We hope that this makes sense, and we believe the Direct Debit Memberships is excellent value for money for regular users.
